

## **BAKERY LICENCE**

The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection hereby informs operators of bakeries in particular and the public in general that, in the context of business facilitation, procedures for the operation of bakeries have been streamlined. Consequently, operators of bakeries no longer require a Bakery Licence from the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Consumer Protection to operate their bakeries; henceforth, they will be able to do so with the appropriate Trade Licence issued by the local authorities.

The Bread (Control of Manufacture and Sale) Regulations 1988 have been revoked and have been replaced by the Consumer Protection (Control of Manufacture and Sale of Bread) Regulations 2018 to give effect to the above **as from 15 January 2019**.

This Ministry will, however, continue to monitor the price and weight of bread.
